DIRECTIONS TO FACILITY Central Texas Youth Rodeo Arena, 1700 Bluebonnet Parkway, McGregor (Waco), TX 76657

From DALLAS/FORT WORTH AREA: Take I-35 to the south side of Waco, exit 330 (Loop 340). Exit right and then right again onto Loop 340/Highway 6 access road and then take entrance ramp left onto Loop 340/Highway 6. Go approximately 1 mile to the Waco Drive (Highway 84) exit. Exit right. Go through the light for Franklin Avenue and turn left onto Waco Drive (Highway 84) at the second light. Stay on Highway 84 West and drive approximately 16 miles to McGregor. Once in McGregor, turn left at the blinking light at Brookshires/Conoco. Go approximately 1 mile and turn right on Bluebonnet Parkway. Go approximately 2 blocks an turn left into the parking lot for the Central Texas Youth Rodeo Arena (large metal building on left).

From AUSTIN OR HOUSTON AREA: Take I-35 north to the south side of Waco. Take exit 330 (Loop 340) right and loop over to Loop 340/Highway 6. Then follow directions above.

CLUB POLICIES

- All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason
 of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of
 public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing
 committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Running order is determined alphabetically. Handlers with more than one dog
 in a class will be separated if possible.
- All dogs for a given class should be present at ring-side at least one-half hour
 prior to the start of the scheduled classes for walk through and briefing. Any
 dog and handler not present when they are called will be ineligible to run.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the show site.
- There will be no refunds for entries in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- A withdrawal from the competition after the closing date due to an injury and/or illness and/or a bitch coming into season after the closing date will be eligible for a refund up to 75% of the total entry fee paid. A veterinarian's notice of injury or illness will be required for a refund.
- Flat ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth places in all jump heights in all classes and for those achieving a qualifying score. No placement ribbons will be awarded in Chances. It is a pass/fail class.

PLEASE VOLUNTEER!

Without your help we cannot put on trials! Club bucks will be awarded! Please complete the volunteer form at the base of the Entry Form and Agreement.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC no longer hand checks for discrepancies the records we send them at the end of the trial. Instead, they post the trial results to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoogroups.com list within two weeks after receiving them from us. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the NADAC Agility list and set your settings to "no mail". You'll be able to view trial results and find discrepancies (if any) without receiving list mail. Contact NADAC only if your registration number or qualifying results are shown incorrectly on the list. Otherwise, you do not need to do anything.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will no longer be banked by NADAC for future use. As of June 1, 2006 if a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1. As used here 'NADAC' means North American Dog Agility Council, Inc., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC, and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (including NADAC officers, directors, employees, and members), Waco Agility Group (including its officers, directors, and members, and event organizing committee), the Central Texas Youth Rodeo Arena (including its officers, agents, and employees) and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury, or death may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
- 1.6. Exhibitor understands there is a returned check fee of \$25. In consideration of the acceptance of the entry, I/we agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC in effect at the time of this trial, and by any additional rules and regulations as approved by the board of NADAC for this trial. I/We certify that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or to other dogs. I/We further agree to be bound by the "Agreement" printed above.
